Shelters/Housing Assistance

Raleigh Rescue Mission; 919-828-9014 www.raleigh-rescue.org

- Emergency shelter for *women and children only*. First come, first serve. Must be in line by 3:30pm.
- Residential recovery provided to both men and women. Operating on a waitlist.

Salvation Army; 919-834-6733 www.salvationarmyraleigh.org

- For *women & children only, males must be 12 or under*. Register by 4:30 pm for emergency shelter admission. Can stay up to 14 continuous nights in one year.
- Longer term shelter operates on a waitlist.

S. Wilmington St Center; 919-857-9428

- For *men only*, 18 years+. Guaranteed bed for first visit. Otherwise an emergency bed list is generated through a lottery system. 234 beds available. Should arrive at 6pm to see if your name is on the list.
- Longer term shelter available but operates on a waitlist.
- Overflow guaranteed emergency shelter is available during certain White Flag winter nights (below 32 degrees)

Wake Interfaith Hospitality Network; 832-6024 www.wihn.org

- Day Center: Open 7-6 M-F Case mgmt. services, employment resources, shower, laundry, mailing address, lockers, phone use.
- Transitional Shelter: 8 wk. program *for married couples or families with children*. Must be employed or have a job 2 wks from entry date.

The Caring Place; 919-462-1800 www.thecaringplace.org Open 9:00-5:00 M-F

- Offers transitional housing and life skill training for 16 weeks to families in need.
- Applicants must be working at least 37hrs/week, have children, be drug free/criminal record free for the previous 12 months, and go through an interview.
- Currently operating with a waitlist that takes weeks to months.

Helen Wright Center; 919-833-1748 Open 4:00pm-9:00am M-F 24hrs Sat-Sun & Holidays

- Transitional Shelter for homeless women (with no kids) offering basic needs & case management. Contracts for initial stay of 2 months.
- Currently operating with a waitlist that takes weeks to months.

PLM Families Together; 919-212-1123 www.plmft.org

- Offers transitional housing and counseling up to 4 months for those “literally” homeless.
- Also offers Re-Housing Support to those who are homeless but who aren’t on the streets. Participants are assigned a Mentor Advocate and they work together to establish permanent housing. Average length of program is 40 days.

Must fill out an application, have proof of residence, your SSN or tax ID, photo ID, proof of income for ALL ADULTS in the household, PAST DUE bill or letter, rental lease or mortgage statement, & documentation of a Financial Crisis (defined as a large unexpected necessary expense or sudden dramatic decrease in wages.)

- Available to Garner residents only. Must have proof of residence, photo ID, social security card for all household members, and a past due bill.
- Help with rent, utilities and prescription medications, (as well as food/clothing)

- Will help 1st 15 people in line. Up to \$100 for utility bill, rent, RX.
- *Must bring ID and social, copy of bill, and proof of having paid rest of said bill.*

- Available to Apex, Holly Spring residents only.
- Must have proof of residence, current NC ID, PAST DUE bill or letter, and documentation of a Financial Crisis (defined as a large unexpected necessary expense or sudden dramatic decrease in wages.)
- Financial assistance for rent, electric, medical. Food pantry.
