Why do we run from the church?

- The Church often doesn't paint a clear image of Jesus.
- We live in an individualistic society that says, "You are your own truth."
- We are more concerned with ourselves than the mission of God.
- We drift away because we get too distracted.
- We miss out because we don't fully understand what the Church is.

Family - Romans 8:16 (NLT)

Body of Christ - Ephesians 4:15-16 (NLT)

Hebrews 10:24 (NLT)

The Church is called to acts of love and good works for others to see and to give God glory.

Matthew 5:16 (NLT)

Connect Intentionally
Serve Selflessly
Give Generously
Share Willingly
