MAIN IDEA

STARTER

APPLY

10 BIBLICAL TRUTHS ABOUT HEAVEN

- 1. Heaven is a real location. (John 14:2; Revelation 6:9-11)
- 2. We will have bodies in heaven. (1 Corinthians 15:47-49)
- 3. When we die we go to heaven immediately. (2 Corinthians 5:8)
- 4. We will have emotions in heaven. (Luke 15:7; Revelation 21:4)
- 5. We will not know everything in heaven. (Revelation 6:10; Mark 13:32; 1 Corinthians 13:12; 1 John 3:2)
 - 6. We will know what is happening on earth. (Revelation 6; Hebrews 12:1; Luke 15:7)
 - 7. We will remember our lives on earth. (Revelation 6)
 - 8. We will know other people in heaven. (1 Corinthians 13:12; Matthew 8:11)
 - 9. Heaven will not be boring. (Revelation 21:1-4)
 - 10. Not everyone will be in heaven. (John 14:6; Matthew 7:22)
