When will campuses open for us to gather together?

Live services are available at the following campuses and times:

Raleigh – Thursdays at 7:00pm and Sundays at 9:30am and 11:15am

Apex & Morrisville – Sundays at 9:30am and 11:15am

Is KidCity Open?

Yes! KidCity is open on Sundays only. KidCity is our ministry for birth through 5th grade. Our Nursery is still closed but we are open for 2 year olds through 5th grade. Please remember to reserve tickets for your child ahead of time. Reserve tickets at gethope.net/services.

Can I take my children into the main worship service?

What procedures is Hope taking with regards to COVID-19?

We will continue to follow the CDC guidelines and mandates set forth by the Governor to maintain social distancing, wearing masks and cleaning our building to prepare for your arrival.

What about Social Distancing?

When you enter and exit the building, just pretend you are at the grocery store and leave 6 feet around you and anyone not in your family. Keep your eyes open for the signs designating entering and exiting, directional dots on the floor, and wait for the Ushers to help you find seats.

What about masks?

We are following the Governor's mandate for Wake County to wear masks while out in public. Our volunteers and staff will be wearing masks, and we will have them at the front doors in case you forget yours. We ask that you wear your mask the entire time you are in the building, even during worship.

What you can expect from us?

Hope will provide a safe environment for all of our attendees while following suggested government-guidelines by doing the following:

1. We will thoroughly sanitize prior to your arrival.
2. We will provide hand-sanitizing stations throughout the building.
3. We will provide disposable masks at the entrances of each building and auditorium.
4. Our staff and volunteers will wear cloth masks while serving you.
5. We will not have complimentary coffee during this time.
6. All water fountains will be closed.

What we ask of you

As you enter the building, please make sure your family members are with you so we can seat you all together.

Stay at home if you're not feeling well.
