Made for More - Week 6

Main Idea

Excuses keep us from experiencing more of the life God wants for us.

Starter

What is one specific way this group and Made for More series has encouraged you to grow in your relationship with Jesus?

Discuss

As you prayed for people in your "3 circles" last week, what did God do in your life? How does seeing yourself as missionary challenge you to think or live differently?



Scripture

Take turns reading Exodus 3:7-4:12 and discuss:

- How does Moses' honest struggle to believe God wants to do more in his life encourage or challenge you?
- Which of the excuses Moses makes do you most relate to? Can you share an example?
 - o I'm not good enough
 - o I don't know enough
 - o I'm not strong enough
 - o I'm not gifted enough
- What is a step of faith you believe God wants you to take? Which of these excuses will you need to overcome to trust God wants more for you?

Apply

As you wrap up this series together, have everyone share and then pray together about

- 1. one main truth about God or themselves they need to embrace more fully.
- 2. one way they want to live more on mission with Jesus in their life.

Before you go, make sure to encourage everyone based on what you've seen the Holy Spirit do during this series and give everyone the "Hope For..." document on the next page as a next step. Have everyone think and pray that resource on their own or in their family. If your group is going to stay together, have everyone bring their thoughts back next week so you can discuss how you can participate together as a group.
