#### Main Idea

If we want to learn to handle money in a healthy way, we need to embrace the principle that "God is the owner, and we are the steward."

### Starter

#### Discuss

When you think back to how you've learned to handle your money, what (or who) has been the biggest influence in this area of your life?

# Scripture

Read Matthew 25:14-30 and discuss:

- How does this passage help you understand what it means to be a "steward" of what God has entrusted you?
- Which of the following Biblical truths from this passage is most convicting or challenging to you? Why?
  - 1. God is the owner of everything
  - 2. God has entrusted me with what I have.
  - 3. God gives different amounts to each person and asks us to be faithful.
  - 4. God will hold us accountable for how we use what He has given us.
- What is one way you are most excited to be investing your talents and resources in God's Kingdom?
- How would your life be different if you embraced the principle that "God is the owner, and you are the steward" more fully in your life?

## Apply

Have everyone take a few minutes to pray and reflect about:

- 1. Is there any way God wants you to think differently about how you handle your money?
- 2. Is there anything God is leading you to do differently with your money?
- 3. What is the next step of faithfulness you could take?

Depending on time, either break up into groups of 2-3 or share with the group what God puts on your heart. Pray for each other as the Holy Spirit leads.
