### ***Where are you going?***

### ***What are the dates and times?***

**8 am** Friday, June 23- **5 pm** Sunday, June 25

### ***What is included in the Registration Fee?***

4 meals, on the beach hotel accommodations for 2 nights & coach bus travel round trip

### ***Where do I drop off my student?***

Hope's Raleigh Campus | 821 Buck Jones Road, Raleigh. We will be traveling on coach buses.

### ***How is housing set up?***

The hotel rooms are queen rooms, 4 people per room with 2 queen beds. We will house same genders together. Adult background checked leaders will be in separate beds than students and there will be 2 adults housed together.

### ***Will there be a chaperone/adult leader in each room?***

There will be leaders responsible for each room. For every three rooms (equaling twelve people), there will be two adults responsible. Adults will participate with students in all sessions and meals and have multiple designated check in times with their assigned students during free times.

### ***What is the curfew and how is it enforced? Room checks?***

The curfew each night is 11 pm. Leaders will be in charge of their groups after the last session and the groups will be staying together, even during late-night activities. Once groups are back in the rooms, in the improbable scenario that one of the students isn't in there, they will report it to Hope staff who will report it to hotel security. Rooms will be checked at night before lights out.

### ***Can students go into other students' rooms?***

Students can only go in other same gender student rooms with adult supervision.

### ***Will they be free to walk around the town?***

No, everyone will be staying at the resort.

### ***Will they need additional money?***

There are 2 traveling meals that students will need to purchase. Lunch before we go to the beach on Friday and Lunch after we leave the hotel on Sunday. We will be stopping at a mall food court. The hotel has an attached restaurant on the outside patio where students can purchase food if desired. There is also a small snack shop with vending type snacks and vending machines on site. There is also an arcade on site that takes coins and there is a coin machine for cash. Vending machines take cash and cards. There is also an ATM on site.

***Can they bring snacks?***

Yes. Some of the rooms will have small refrigerators but it is best to bring snacks that are non-refrigerated.

***How long will they be outside on the beach?***

We will have time on the beach each day, for varying amounts of time. We will have extended amounts of beach time on Friday from arrival to 4pm room check in and again on Saturday from 1- 5pm. Other times on the beach, they will be in small groups.

***Is there an alternative to being in the sun?***

We will have a designated area on the beach that will include Sunshades. The hotel also has an indoor pool. We will provide water coolers while on the beach. Students should pack a water bottle to refill. Be sure to send sunscreen with your student.

***Dress code?***

Clothing should be long enough to keep you fully covered in all situations - sitting, standing, bending. Footwear is required indoors.

***What about swimsuits?***

For guys no speedos and for ladies, whether 1 or 2-pieced, it should fully cover breasts and butt.

***Is there a phone policy?***

During session and small group times students will be expected to not be on phones. Phones may be asked to be put in basket with small group leader during small group times as necessary.
