# Vision and Mission of Groups at Hope

- A safe place: to belong, connect intentionally, be loved where they are, and engage the Gospel.
- **To learn:** to be established in the truth of God's Word and encouraged to grow in relationship with Jesus in a supportive community.
- Live on mission: to discover their role to live on mission where they live, learn, work, and play.

Groups are not a place to keep us safe from a scary world, but a way to help others discover the Gospel in a supportive community that is changing the world.
