Main Idea

The Holy Spirit moves Christ followers to connect intentionally in community rather than staying in isolation.

Starter

What is the most meaningful team or group you've been a part of? Why was it significant for you?

Discuss

What is a way you are grateful for how this group helped you grow in your relationship with Jesus?

Scripture

Take turns reading [Acts 2:42-47](#).

- Make a list of practices that the Christians in this passage devoted themselves to.
- What is most striking to you about the description of their life together? How do you think it felt to be part of this Christian community?
- What principles can we learn from their example?
- How does the devotion of the early Christians to each other and to Jesus' mission challenge you?

Apply

As a group, discuss how God might be leading your group to grow in greater ways together.

- Make a list of anyone who might have fallen away from your group. Spend some time praying and assign someone to reach out to them in the next week or so.
- Then, discuss your Group Growth Plan together.
 - If you've already created one, discuss any celebrations or challenges you've experienced so far.
