Fresh Start Week 1 Message Based Curriculum

Opening

- Begin with a brief welcome and prayer to set the tone for the group time.
- Introduce the theme: Seeking God for a fresh start in life by examining Nehemiah Chapter 1.

Discussion Questions

1. How do you feel about New Years Resolutions?

- o Do you have any resolutions this year?
- Why do you think most people don't see their NY resolutions through?

This week, Jason shared 4 action steps we can take from Nehemiah 1 to help us experience a fresh start with God. As a group, read Nehemiah 1:5-11 and then discuss the following questions surrounding each of the action steps.

1. Take Inventory:

- Taking inventory is ultimately about honestly assessing your life and recognizing areas that need a change. Why is this sometimes easy to do, and why can it be challenging at times?
- When are you most likely to evaluate your life and take inventory?

2. Brokenness:

- Nehemiah's response to the report was weeping, mourning, fasting, and praying. How do you respond when confronted with brokenness in your life or community?
- o How is the type of brokenness we see in Nehemiah a good thing?

3. Turn to God in Prayer:

- What do you notice about Nehemiah's prayer? (Reread verses 5-11 if you need a refresher). How is it similar or different from how you typically pray?
- o Why is prayer necessary for a fresh start?

4. Take Action:

- Not only did Nehemiah pray, but he took action. How do faith and action go hand in hand?
- Is there a step of faith you feel God is calling you to take for a fresh start in your life, family, or community?
- As a group, is there anything we can do to help hold one another accountable?

Prayer Time

- Either break into pairs or smaller groups or as a group share and pray for one another.
 - o Pray for the areas where we need a fresh start.
 - Pray for humility and boldness to take action.

- Pray for unity and growth as a church family and as a small group. : Ask
 God to help you surrender any areas where you are holding back from fully following Jesus.
- Pray for Boldness: That each person would boldly embrace the gospel and live it out in their daily lives.
- Pray for Baptisms: If anyone has not been baptized, pray for clarity and boldness to take this next step of faith.

Closing

 Remind your group that throughout this entire series, we'll be focusing on the book of Nehemiah. Encourage them to revisit each chapter every week or consider doing a reading plan through the book of Nehemiah together.
