

Week 9 Message-Based Curriculum

Text: 1 John 5:13-21

Opening

- Begin with a **brief welcome and prayer** to set the tone for the group time.
- Introduce the theme: This week we are closing out our study through 1st John. This series hasn't been about removing uncertainty from life—but about **anchoring** ourselves to what is eternally true through a relationship with God.

Discussion Questions CONNECT

- Have you ever been absolutely confident in something only for that thing to let you down?
- When life feels uncertain, where are you most tempted to look for stability and control?
- Which is harder for you: Not realizing what's coming next or admitting you were confident in the wrong thing?

DISCOVER

Read John 17:3 together

 How does Jesus define eternal life in this verse? How is it different from how we normally think about eternal life?

Read 1 John 5:13-21 together

- How does Jesus' definition of eternal life from John 17:3 reframe 1 John 5:13?
- In vv. 14-15 on prayer, what stands out to you about the confidence John says believers can have before God in prayer?
- How does praying "according to His will" challenge the way we usually think about unanswered prayers?
- In vv. 16-17 John talks about the "sin that does not to lead to death" or unconfessed sin.
 - O Why do you think confession is so important for the Christian life?
 - o What practices of confession do you have in your own life?
- In vv. 21, John ends with the warning to keep away from idols.
 - O Why do you think John ends the letter this way?
 - How can good things quietly become substitutes for God in our lives?

 What is one "false sense of security" you need to loosen your grip on this week?

PRACTICE FOR THE WEEK:

- Confess one area where you've been looking for certainty outside of Christ.
- Pray daily—not to control outcomes—but to realign your trust with God's will.
- Name Jesus as Lord in moments of stress, fear, or temptation.

GROUP PRAYER

This week, we are going to tie our prayer requests to what we've been talking about:

Pray together for:

- Honest confession and renewed confidence in Christ
- Deeper knowledge of God, not just more information
- Freedom from idols that promise security but can't deliver

CLOSING

Share Christmas plans and a reminder to invite others to Christmas Eve services. Encourage your group to sit together for services if you're all attending the same ones.
